



Mark Huffman, MD, MPH, is an Assistant Professor of Preventive Medicine and Medicine-Cardiology at the Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine and adjunct faculty at the Northwestern Center for Global Health in the Northwestern Institute for Public Health and Medicine.
