



### **Dr. Joseph L. Pater**

Dr. Pater recently completed a three-year term at Cancer Care Ontario as the Vice-President of Clinical and Translational Research. In this position, he oversaw CCO's existing program of networks of research in the areas of cancer imaging, experimental therapeutics, populations studies, and health services research and was responsible for developing new initiatives to support scientists and

research units.

A graduate of Georgetown University, Dr. Pater received his MD from Case Western Reserve University in Cleveland, Ohio, and completed specialty training in hematology/oncology. He holds an MSc in Clinical Epidemiology and Biostatistics from McMaster University.

Dr. Pater was Director of the National Cancer Institute of Canada Clinical Trials Group from 1980 to 2007, where he took an active part in the development, execution and analysis of over 100 cooperative cancer trials.

Dr. Pater is an Emeritus Professor at Queen's University, where he held the Edith Eisenhower Chair in Clinical Cancer Research from 2000 to 2007. He has served on numerous research advisory bodies and selection committees in Ontario, in Canada and internationally, particularly in the United Kingdom.

In 2006, Dr. Pater received the R.M. Taylor Award for outstanding contributions to the cancer field. In 2007, he received the Golden Jubilee Award from the National Cancer Institute of Canada for outstanding contributions to clinical cancer research.
